Accessibility Information

Gardners Lane Children and Family Centre:

At Gardners Lane venue there is disabled parking in the children and family centre car park which will be available.

Main entrance to the children and family centre is accessible for all with an automatic door and flat flooring at entrance.

Disabled toilets are located close to the family room where the activity will be delivered.

Quiet spaces will be available throughout the activity session, where children will be able to engage in books, quiet activities or take time to relax. A sensory room is also available and will be able to accessed during the session.

Oakwood Children and Family Centre:

At Oakwood Venue there is disabled parking in the children and family centre car park which will be available.

There is ramp access to the main entrance of the children and family centre and an automatic door to access the building. Additional entrance routes to the building are also available.

Disabled toilets are located close to the family room where the activity will be delivered.

Quiet spaces will be available throughout the activity session, where children will be able to engage in books, quiet activities or take time to relax. A sensory room is also available and will be able to accessed during the session.
