

No Child Left Behind Party in the Park 2026 “Prize Draw” – Terms and Conditions

1. Cheltenham Borough Council, Municipal Offices, Promenade, Cheltenham, GL50 9SA is the “Promoter”.
2. Entry is via the Microsoft Form.
3. To enter the free prize draw, entrants must submit their entries via the Microsoft form link including a valid email address.
4. Four individual prizes will be included in the draw, available for four individual winners. These include:

- 4 free tickets to Dear Zoo at Cheltenham Town Hall
- A free family swim (for up to 4 people)
- 2 Free tickets to the Halloween event at the leisure centre
- 1-month free membership at Leisure @ Cheltenham

The promoter reserves the right to provide a substitute prize of similar value should the Prize become unavailable for reasons beyond its control.

5. The opening date for entries is Wednesday the 26th of August 2026. The closing date of the prize draw is Wednesday the 9th of September 2026. Entries received after this time will not be entered into the prize draw.

6. Entrants must be UK residents aged 18 years or over and either have attended Party in the Park 2026 themselves or be the parent, guardian or responsible adult of an attendee. 7. Only one entry per person/family will be accepted. Multiple or incomplete entries will be deemed to be invalid.

7. The prize draw is free to enter and no purchase is necessary.

8. The prize draw is not open to the Promoter, its agencies, group companies or anyone professionally connected with the administration of the prize draw. Employees of the Promoter, their immediate families and agents are not eligible to enter.

9. By entering the prize draw, the entrant is deemed to accept these Terms and Conditions and those of any relevant third party. Entries not complying with these Terms and Conditions will be invalid and will result in disqualification from the prize draw. If these Terms and Conditions are not accepted in full, then entrants should not enter this prize draw.

10. The Promoter also reserves the right to disqualify from the prize draw any entrant suspected of fraud or cheating including, without limitation, through the manipulation of codes, multiple computer generated entries, or otherwise fraudulently falsifying data or acting fraudulently or dishonestly in the opinion of the promoter.

11. There will be four winners. Winners will be selected at random from all eligible entries received before the closing date. The first winner drawn will receive Prize 1, the second winner drawn will receive Prize 2, the third winner drawn will receive Prize 3 and the fourth winner drawn will receive Prize 4.

12. The prize draw will take place on Thursday the 10th of September 2026 and the winner will be notified by Friday the 11th of September 2026.

13. If a winner cannot be contacted, is ineligible, declines the prize, or fails to claim it within one month, the Promoter reserves the right to select an alternative winner at random from the remaining eligible entries. The winner has one month after notification to claim the prize.

14. The promoter’s decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

15. The promoter cannot accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by any person as a result of entering the prize draw or as a result of accepting the prize. The promoter gives no warranty or guarantee in relation to the prize. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions shall exclude the liability of the promoter for death or personal injury as a result of its negligence.

16. By entering this prize draw the entrant agrees that the promoter may use their name for

promotional purposes (including confirming the prize draw winner) on the promoter's website, social media and within promotional emails. The winner may be asked to participate in PR or publicity activities resulting from the Prize Draw. No compensation shall be awarded for such participation.

17. The Prize will only be sent to a winner if and when the promoter is satisfied of the winner's eligibility. The promoter may at its discretion disqualify any entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of these Terms and Conditions. The promoter may also exercise this discretion to select an alternative winner.

18. Personal data will be processed in accordance with applicable data protection legislation, including the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018. Entrants' personal information will be used by the Promoter for the purposes of the administration of this Competition.

19. If the entrants expressly and separately consent, their personal information will also be used for future marketing purposes.

20. By entering the Prize Draw, entrants acknowledge that if they win, the Promoter may publish their first name and surname initial for the purpose of administering and promoting the Prize Draw.

21. The Promoter reserves the right to delay, postpone or cancel the prize draw in the event of circumstances outside its reasonable control, which it considers make it necessary for it to do so.

22. If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is held invalid by any law, rule, order or regulation of any government, or by the final determination of any court of a competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the enforceability of any other provisions not held to be invalid.

23. The promoter accepts no responsibility for incorrectly completed, lost or delayed entries, notices, acceptances, tickets or other documents related to the Prize Draw or the Prize. Proof of transmission will not be accepted as proof of receipt.

24. The promoter will not be liable for system failures, network errors, errors or unavailability of the website, or the entrant's email account, hacks on the system or personal computer/ mobile device issues including but not limited to internet connectivity.

25. The instructions provided at the point of entry form part of the Terms and Conditions of this Prize Draw, and in the event of a conflict, these Terms and Conditions take precedence.

26. The promoter reserves the rights to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time. Revised Terms and Conditions will be available on the promoter's website.

27. The Prize Draw and these Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of England and Wales. The promoter and the entrants hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.

28. Entries submitted through Microsoft Forms will be deemed received only when successfully recorded by the Promoter. The Promoter is not responsible for incomplete submissions caused by technical failures or interruptions.
